Benefits of being an Alumni Artist

Alumni Artist are invited to the first Saturday performance of every show in the Gate programme with a complimentary ticket; they are also invited to Gate press night and summer parties.

The Gate Theatre will provide an annual workshop for Alumni Artists and an annual networking event with Artistic Director Ellen McDougall.

As well as celebrating and collaborating with them all, Alumni Artists are top of the list when it comes to invitations to see work. Although we are open to invitations from all artists, we have a notice period of 4-6 weeks. Alumni Artists can invite us to work within 2-4 weeks.

Alumni Artists are welcome to book a hot desk space with us, if they would like to work remotely from our venue, we'd be happy to book them in. This can be done through our Projects and Community Officer, Valerie at valerie@gatetheatre.co.uk
